All non-exempt farms are required to have at least one person on the the farm who has attended an approved FSMA PSR training. Even if you are exempt, you are required to keep specific records, which we will cover in the workshop. There will be time for discussion, so come prepared to share your experiences and produce safety questions. From beginners to experienced growers, everyone can benefit from taking the time to think about produce safety!
